Meeting Goal

The primary objective of this initial meeting was to establish clarity, build professional relationships, and identify initial concerns and priorities to guide the committee's future work.

Committee Purpose & Rationale

- **Objective:** To gather feedback and perspectives from key stakeholders to support the implementation of metal detectors at both high schools.
- Focus: Ensuring the rollout is transparent, equitable, respectful, and causes minimal disruption to students, staff, and instruction.
- The "Why": Data from the Lynchburg Police Department (LPD) and student services indicate that high-school-aged students have access to firearms in the community and have brought them to school.

Implementation Plan & Equipment

- Phased Rollout: E.C. Glass (ECG) will pilot the program first because it has a simpler setup and a smaller project scope compared to Heritage High School (HHS).
- **Equipment Specs:** The detectors are lightweight, portable, have a 40+ hour battery life, and feature adjustable settings.
- **Expansion:** The units are affordable enough to allow for future project expansion.
- Primary Goal: The detectors serve as a deterrent with the ultimate goal of detecting firearms.

Key Discussion Points & Concerns

- Operations: Concerns were raised regarding manpower, staff training, and the specific "trigger settings" for the detectors.
- Logistics: The committee discussed the process for items that should not pass through the detectors, such as sports equipment.
- **Timing:** Potential issues include student tardiness, the arrival distribution of buses (6:45 AM - 7:20 AM), and the movement of students to off-site programs like Governor's School.
- Maintenance: Every device should have a backup battery, and a clear rotation for charging must be established.

Action Items & Information Needed

- Data Collection: The committee needs bus arrival times, entry traffic flow data, and the number of doors currently in use.
- Staffing: Principals are to send a list of approximately 15 staff members (including backups) to Nick Caputo.
- Simulation: A mock-up of equipment and throughput times is requested
