Lynchburg City Schools provides the following guidance and counseling services to students:

- <u>Academic Guidance</u> programs assist students and their parents in acquiring information about the curricular choices available in planning a program of studies, arranging and interpreting academic testing, and seeking post-secondary academic opportunities.
- <u>Career Guidance</u> programs help students acquire information and plan action about work, jobs, apprenticeships, and post-secondary educational and career opportunities.
- <u>Personal/ Social Counseling</u> programs are available to assist students in developing an understanding of themselves, recognizing the rights and needs of others, resolving conflicts, and defining individual goals reflecting their interests, abilities, and aptitudes.
