#### Look what's growing at the Virtual Academy

At our February in-person event, our middle school students planted zinnias, marigolds, and sunflowers. Planting was connected to learning about the energy transformation of photosynthesis as well as the importance of producers in ecosystems and the carbon cycle, symbiotic relationships with pollinators, and preservation of soil and water quality by reducing erosion.
