REGISTRATION REMINDER

Can you believe it? The first day of school is Wednesday, August 11! Thank you to all our families for working with us to get ready for the new school year.

What documents do you need to provide before the first day of school?

Click here for the LCS Registration Checklist.

- Two proofs of residency for all students
- Immunization record, physical, and birth certificate for new students
- <u>Immunization</u> record for some returning students, especially those entering 7th and 12 grades

Where do you provide your documentation?

Even though your child is enrolled in the Virtual Academy, you will still need to bring your registration documents to your child's BASE SCHOOL. Each base school has specific registration dates to collect these documents, so reach out to the school to arrange a time to provide these documents.

What else do I need to do for the new year?

Be sure to complete your Online Registration application. Returning parents can do this in their <u>LCS Infinite Campus Parent Portal</u> (if you have a new child entering along with returning children, you can just add that child to your application in your Parent Portal).
