



#### **Holiday Sugar Cookie Recipe**

Below is the recipe and instructions on making the sugar cookies. We look forward to having you join us as we make them together virtually. Please substitute any items due to food allergies.



#### **Ingredients**

- 1 cup butter (2 sticks), room temperature
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 ½ tsp vanilla
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon water (a bit more if needed)
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 ½ tsp baking powder
- 1/4 tsp salt

#### **Holiday Sugar Cookie Recipe Instructions**

Please join us from your home at 6:30pm on December 16th as we all enjoy this fun activity!



Step 1. Cream butter, sugar and vanilla.

Step 2. Add egg and water. Beat until light and fluffy.

Step 3. In a new bowl, combine flour, baking powder and salt. Sift together.

Step 4. Blend dry mixture into creamed mixture, divide dough in half. Wrap each half in waxed paper or plastic wrap and chill for one hour (optional).

Step 5. When you are ready to roll your dough, make sure to flour your working surface. If your dough feels too sticky, add a little bit of flour. If your dough seems too dry, add a tiny bit of water and knead.

Step 6. Roll your dough on the floured surface with a rolling pin. Approximately ¼ inch thick.

Step 7. Bake at 375 degrees for 6-8 minutes. Watch them carefully. Take out of oven before edges turn brown.

Homemade Icing:

Start with 2 cups of powdered sugar. Add 1 teaspoon vanilla and 1 tablespoon melted butter. Stir in teaspoons of milk one at a time until you reach desired consistency.


