21st Century Program

As we come to the end of the first semester, we have been evaluating the after-school program. Our 21^{st} Century Grant is funded through the Virginia Department of Education. We have received guidance that the program should focus on specific academic needs of the students. As we proceed into the second semester, the afterschool program will be by invite only. Invites for the after-school program will go out at the end of December. Please return them as soon as possible to secure your student's placement. The before-school program will remain open for $2^{nd} - 5^{th}$ grade students.

As a reminder: The before school program runs from 7:15 - 8:15 and is for students in 2nd- 5th grade. Please make sure to bring your students into the office and check them in for the program. Please do not allow the students to come in on their own. Also, students for the before school program will need to be at school by 7:25. We will not allow late arrivers, after 7:25, as it interrupts the learning environment. If you are not able to get your student to school for the morning program by 7:25, they will be able to arrive at 8:15 for the regular school day. Thank you for your understanding and support.
